

The Prader-Willi Syndrome Association of Utah Grant Program

The Utah Prader-Willi Syndrome Association (UPWSA) will consider funding for programs, initiatives, research or projects within the state of Utah that support our mission of enhancing the quality of life and empowering those affected by Prader-Willi syndrome.

UPWSA accepts applications from academic, government, nonprofit, and for profit entities and individuals. UPWSA defines affected individuals as those diagnosed along with their support networks, families and communities.

To apply for a UPWSA Grant, submit a 1-page letter of intent that must include:

- 1. Organization name
- 2. Contact information
- 3. Statement of need
- 4. Purpose of project and description
- 5. Budget, including time frame, performance measures and expected outcomes
- 6. List any degrees, licenses, affiliations, or certification that indicate the qualifications of the applicant
- 7. Statement of scope describing how many individuals affected by Prader-Willi syndrome will be impacted

Successful letters of intent recipients will be invited to complete a grant application.

Grant requests of \$500-\$50,000 will be considered.
